## **Installation Instructions**

- 1. Disconnect the negative battery cable.
- 2. Raise and support the vehicle. A vehicle lift is highly recommended for this installation.
- 3. From the under side of the vehicle loosen band clamp at the joint where intermediate pipe joins the outlet of the O.E.M. Y-pipe. Remove the brace that hangs below this joint. Slide the intermediate pipe and muffler assembly rearward until the slip joint comes apart.
- 4. Loosen and unbolt each of the two flanges at the catalytic converter assembly outlets and remove the OEM Y-Pipe from the vehicle.
- 5. Next install the driver's side elbow onto the outlet of the flange at the catalytic converter assembly.
- 6. Next install short Y-Pipe onto the outlet of the driver's side elbow and onto the outlet of the passenger's side flange at the catalytic converter assembly.
- 7. Used the supplied clamp to secure the driver's side elbow to the short y-pipe.
- 8. Slide the muffler assembly and intermediate pipe forward.
- 9. Check for clearances to all body parts and tighten down each clamp, nut and bolt.
- 10. The installation is now complete.
