

## Axle-Back Exhaust, 2008-2009 Pontiac G8 PowerFlo

Before installation, use this checklist to make sure all necessary parts have been included.

**WARNING:** SLP Recommends allowing the vehicle to cool (not running) for five hours before beginning installation.

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS - #31190

- Raise and fully support the vehicle (a vehicle lift is recommended). If you do not have access to a lift, you may raise the rear using a jack to gain access to the necessary bolts.




Figure 1: Factory bolts to be removed

- Remove the two bolts behind each muffler as well as the gaskets and set aside to be reused later. See Figure 1 below.

Next, carefully remove each muffler off of the rubber isolators and discard. See Figure 2 below.

- 4 Next, slide a Torca clamp over the larger side of one of the mufflers, then slide in one of the under axle pipes. Loosely tighten. Repeat with other side.
- Next, Slide a Torca clamp over one of the exhaust tips and insert onto the muffler. Be sure to place the left tip on the left muffler and vice versa. Repeat for other side. Loosely tighten.

Slide the driver's side axle-back section onto the rubber isolator and insert the bolts you removed earlier back into the flange. Be sure not to forget the gasket. See Figure 3 below. Tighten the bolts to 25 ft-lbs.

- Now you should make adjustments to align the tip correctly, and tighten the two (2) Torca Clamps.
- Repeat Steps 7 and 8 for the passenger side. The finished system should look like Figure 4.
